## Revised Invitation for Bids (IFB)

The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received loans from the Asian Development Bank (herein after called "the ADB") towards the cost of the Gas Transmission and Development Project and it is intended that a part of the funds will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for which this Rebidding Document is issued.

The Gas Transmission Company Limited (herein after called "the Purchaser") now invites two (2) sealed Revised Bids from eligible Bidders from member countries of the ADB for the supply and delivery of (i) Pipeline Induction Bends 762mm OD (30") with a centerline radius of 5D to 40D and (ii) Miscellaneous Fittings for the Construction of 762mm OD (30") 51.00 km high pressure (1135 Psig) natural gas transmission pipeline from Monohordi to Dhanua and Elenga to East Bank of Jamuna Bridge (Details and Specifications are provided in each Revised Bidding Documents).

Delivery and services under the contract shall be completed as per time mentioned in the following table counting from 30 (thirty) days after issuance of Commitment Letter by the ADB.
